Covers large-scale IT systems in the area of Freedom, Security and Justice



Amsterdam - London - Singapore

Article 111 outlines that, on an exceptional basis, and in light of public accountability, operators of AI systems which are components of the large-scale IT systems established by the legal acts listed in an annex to this Regulation and operators of high-risk AI systems that are intended to be used by public authorities should, respectively, take the necessary steps to comply with the requirements of this Regulation by end of 2030. This presentation examines data from the European Commission's State of Schengen Report 2024 to outline how the EU AI Act is intricately related to the Schengen area, particularly through its focus on migration, asylum, and border control management. Specifically, it focuses on support for the Schengen Area's contributions to Europe's digital future with **secure digital border solutions**.


